

FAMOUS TOURIST DESTINATIONS IN BIRBHUM

Fullara Mata Temple

Labhpur (also spelt Labpur. Bengali script: লাভপুর), is a small Town with a block office, a police station in Bolpur subdivision of Birbhum district. Known to the outside world as the native place of Tarashankar Bandopadhyay. The main attraction of the place is the beautiful temple of Fullara Maata.

The myth is that, the lip of Sati cut down at Fullara. It is one of the 51 Pithas or Sacred places where Sati's dead body fell. The temple is almost 100 years old. Labhpur Fullaratala is famous for the temple of Goddess Fullara and lake named Daldali. As a substitute there is a piece of tortoise-shaped rock admired by the disciples. A 10-day fair is held at the Fullara temple in every year during Magh Purnima.
